## **ASSOCIATED HERDS**

Sometimes there will be a need for a herd to be analysed in Wagyu BREEDPLAN in association with other herds.

For example, when a number of breeders all run their animals together on the same property, such as may occur with family members. In this case, the animals are recorded as being bred by different breeders (and therefore have different herd ids) but should be **directly compared** for performance analysis.

For this association type we need to know the herds involved and the primary performance herd with which the secondary herds are running.

If for any reason one or more secondary herds ceases to belong to this group, we need to be notified of an approximate date when this occurred.
